### DRESS CODE RESTRICTIONS

1. No shorts, skirts, dresses, splits, or holes in clothing shorter than four inches above the knee.

4. No tank tops, low cut, see-through, midriff, muscle, or off the shoulder shirts, or shirts that expose excessive skin.
5. No head coverings, sunglasses, pajamas, slides, or bedroom shoes are to be worn on campus during school hours.
6. No inappropriate or profane signs, emblems, or language which will disrupt the learning environment is permitted.

### LOCKS / LOCKERS

A school lock must be purchased to be assigned a school locker. School locks are \$7.00 and can be purchased during New Student Orientation or from the Safe School Coordinator during the school year. PE Students may use personal locks to secure their personal belongings in a locker in the locker room during Health/PE class and remove the lock each period for the next class.

### TRANSPARENT/MESH BOOKBAGS

Transparent/mesh bookbags are allowed in classrooms. Book bags, duffel bags, large purses, instrument cases, or similar items may be used for the purpose of transporting books, other school related items and personal effects to and from school. Upon entering the school, all book bags, duffel bags, large purses, instrument cases, or similar items, **unless transparent or mesh** must be secured in a school locker.
